- **What is e-Sgoil?**

e-Sgoil is based in the Western Isles of Scotland. Since its inception, e-Sgoil's main driver has been to enhance equity in terms of subject choice for all pupils, irrespective of geographic location.

Utilising digital tools & platforms, e-Sgoil has sought to both enhance and enrich pupil experience by looking to remove the barriers which restrict choice for young people. Having recently piloted a programme for Interrupted Learners accessing lessons from home, e-Sgoil is well placed to support young people across Scotland with their learning.

- **What is the e-Sgoil Easter Study Support National Offer?**

In order to enable learners to consolidate their learning, e-Sgoil is offering a programme of Study Support for senior phase pupils in Scottish schools. This provision is free to access and will be delivered to pupils in their homes.
