Thank you for your interest in the Gaelic (Learners) course with e-Sgoil, in partnership with UHI North, West and Hebrides. These courses, which run at National 5, Higher and Advanced Higher, aim to offer adults the chance to gain a recognised qualification in Gaelic and to allow for progression from previous learning.

The course fee for this has been set by our college partner UHI as £355, which is the amount agreed by their board for all NQ courses offered through the college.

Places are limited and the deadline for confirming your application for this course is 5pm on Friday 9th August 2024.

Official course registration and course fee payment must be completed before the start date of the course, or your place will be withdrawn.

The course will run w/b 26th August 2024 - w/b 24th March 2025. Classes will be off over the Christmas period and therefore there will be no classes w/b 23rd December or w/b 30th December 2024. Classes will resume from w/b 6th January.
